

What does sexual harassment mean?

Verbal: sexual jokes or comments, mean comments about men, women, or LGBTQ, asking someone out after they already said no, comments about someone's body

Physical: Unwanted sexual touch, showing sexual body parts

Cyber: using phones or internet to harass...sending naked photos, stalking online, sending sexual text messages

What should I do if someone harasses me?

Sexual Harassment at Work

It makes people feel unsafe and uncomfortable. Here is how you can stay safe, and respect other people

What's not okay to talk about at work?

At Work, I Cannot Talk About.....

- Sex or body parts
- Comment on a person's body
- Boyfriends, girlfriends, or crushes
- Asking co-workers or job coaches out on dates

Talking about these things could result in getting **fired!**

If you believe someone is sexually harassing you.....

- Tell your employer, job coach, or someone you trust
- Use assertiveness skills to tell the person what they said is not okay. Avoid that person if possible.
- You may need to file a report with your employer
